

Dear Postal Customer:

Each winter our letter carriers suffer from injuries and vehicle accidents when facing the harshness of bad weather. In order to keep our letter carriers safe this winter, we have required of them that they ensure:

- That the path to your box is clear of snow and ice to prevent slips and falls (for walking routes)
- That the approach to your curbside box is clear of snow, ice and other obstructions which would prevent the carrier from pulling up to and away from your box safely and without backing.

Your letter carrier is **not permitted to deliver mail** at an address that poses an obvious hazard, if your carrier is unable to deliver the mail, then he/she will hold the mail until safe delivery can be resumed.

Please help us maintain your daily mail delivery service. Thank you!!!
